*Dine in elegance with these classy floral designs enhancing your table and wall. Choose one or all of the projects, each of which is simple to make. The printed panel does most of the work, and once the quilting is done, it will look like you appliquéd the flowers.*

## Cutting Directions

**Note:** Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include ¼" seam allowances. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus ¼" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

**Fabric A** Fussy-cut (1) 1panel 23½" x 42½"

**Fabric B** Cut (20) rectangles 3" x 4"

**Fabric C** Cut (2) side borders 1½" x 42½", cut crosswise  
Cut (2) top/bottom borders 1½" x 25½", cut crosswise

**Fabric D** Cut (3) strips 2½" x WOF, pieced to make the following:  
(2) side borders 2½" x 46½"  
Cut (2) t/b borders 3" x 34½"

**Fabric E** Cut (2) borders 1½" x 30½"  
Cut (18) strips 1½" x 3"

**Binding** Cut (5) strips 2½" x WOF for binding

**Backing** Cut (1) length 42" x 59"

## Wall Hanging: 34" x 51"

Fabric Requirements	Yardage	Fabric
<b>Fabric A</b> center	1 panel	818D-B
<b>Fabric B</b> set	¼ yard	820D-L
<b>Fabric C</b> border	¼ yard	821D-B1
<b>Fabric D</b> border	½ yard	822D-B
<b>Fabric E</b> set	¼ yard	822D-Y
<b>Binding</b>	¾ yard	822D-Y
<b>Backing</b>	1¾ yards	819D-Y

## Making the Wall Hanging

1. Fussy-cut the panel the size listed to leave ¼" seam allowance all around the motif.
2. Sew long Fabric C borders to the sides of the panel. Sew short Fabric C borders to the top and bottom.
3. Referring to the Quilt Assembly, join 10 Fabric B rectangles alternately with 9 Fabric E strips to make a border. Sew to the side of the quilt. Repeat for the opposite side.
4. Sew Fabric E borders to the top and bottom. Sew long Fabric D borders to the sides, and then sew shorter Fabric D borders to the top and bottom.

## Finishing the Wall Hanging

5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders. Quilt around the printed motifs in the center panel. Bind to finish the quilt.

Fabric Requirements	Yardage	Fabric
<b>*Fabric A</b> center	1 panel	818D-B
<b>Fabric B</b> set	fat ⅛	820D-L
<b>Fabric C</b> border	fat ⅛	821D-B1
<b>Fabric D</b> border	¼ yard	822D-B
<b>Fabric E</b> set	fat ⅛	822D-Y
<b>Binding</b>	¼ yard	822D-Y
<b>Backing</b>	1 yard	819D-Y

\*One panel makes the table runner and 4 placemats.

## 4 Placemats: 12" x 18½" each

Fabric Requirements	Yardage	Fabric
<b>*Fabric A</b> center	1 panel	818D-B
<b>Fabric B</b> set	¼ yard	820D-L
<b>Fabric C</b> border	fat ⅛	821D-B1
<b>Fabric D</b> border	¼ yard	822D-B
<b>Fabric E</b> set	fat ⅛	822D-Y
<b>Binding</b>	½ yard	822D-Y
<b>Backing</b>	1 yard	819D-Y

\*One panel makes the table runner and 4 placemats.

### Cutting Directions

**Note:** Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include ¼" seam allowances. A fat ⅛ is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus ¼" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

**Fabric A** Fussy-cut (3) squares 10½"

**Fabric B** Cut (8) rectangles 3" x 4"

**Fabric C** Cut (4) sashes 1¼" x 10½"

**Fabric D** Cut (3) strips 1½" x WOF, pieced to make the following: (2) side borders 1½" x 45"  
Cut (2) t/b borders 1½" x 12½"  
Cut (2) sashes 1¼" x 10½"

**Fabric E** Cut (12) rectangles 1½" x 3"

**Binding** Cut (3) strips 2½" x WOF for binding

**Backing** Cut (2) lengths 18" x 27", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

### Making the Table Runner

1. Fussy-cut 3 of the printed squares, including ¼" seam allowances all around the printed motif.
2. Join 3 Fabric E rectangles alternately with 2 Fabric B rectangles. Make 4 pieced units like this. Set aside.
3. Sew Fabric C sashes to the top and bottom of 2 Fabric A squares. Sew Fabric D sashes to the top and bottom of the third Fabric A square.
4. Referring to the Quilt Assembly, arrange the pieced units from Step 2 with the 3 Fabric A squares in a vertical column. Be sure the Fabric D sashes are in the middle. Join the parts to make the table runner.
5. Layer the runner with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders. Quilt around the printed motifs. Bind to finish the quilt.

### Cutting Directions

**Note:** Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include ¼" seam allowances. A fat ⅛ is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus ¼" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

#### Cutting for 1 Placemat

**Fabric A** Fussy-cut (1) square 10½"

**Fabric B** Cut (4) rectangles 3" x 4"

**Fabric C** Cut (2) sashes 1¼" x 10½"

**Fabric D** Cut (2) borders 1½" x 18½"  
Cut (2) borders 1¼" x 10½"

**Fabric E** Cut (6) rectangles 1½" x 3"

**Binding** Cut (2) strips 2½" x WOF for binding (Use leftover strip for another placemat).

**Backing** Cut (1) length 15" x 21", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

# Windowpane Projects

## Making the Placemat

1. Fussy-cut the square, including  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance all around.
2. Sew Fabric C sashes to opposite sides.
3. Join 3 Fabric E rectangles alternately with 2 Fabric B rectangles. Sew to the side of the placemat. Repeat for the opposite side.
4. Sew short Fabric D borders to the sides. Sew long borders to the top and bottom.
5. Layer the placemat with batting and backing and baste. Hint: Use a heavyweight fusible interfacing to make the placemat stiffer. Quilt as you desire. Bind to finish.

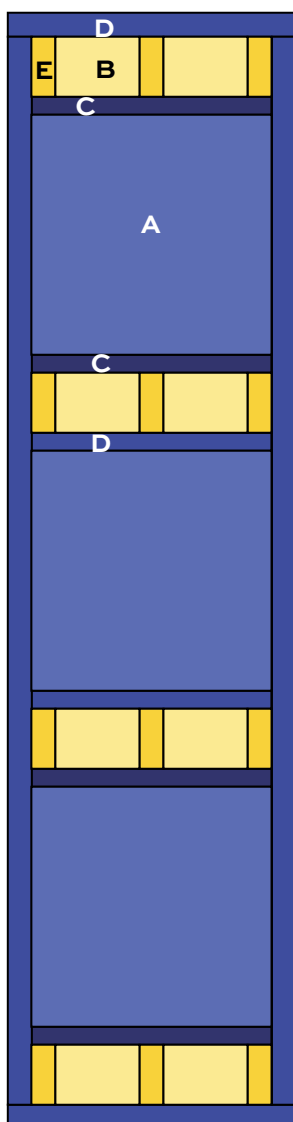
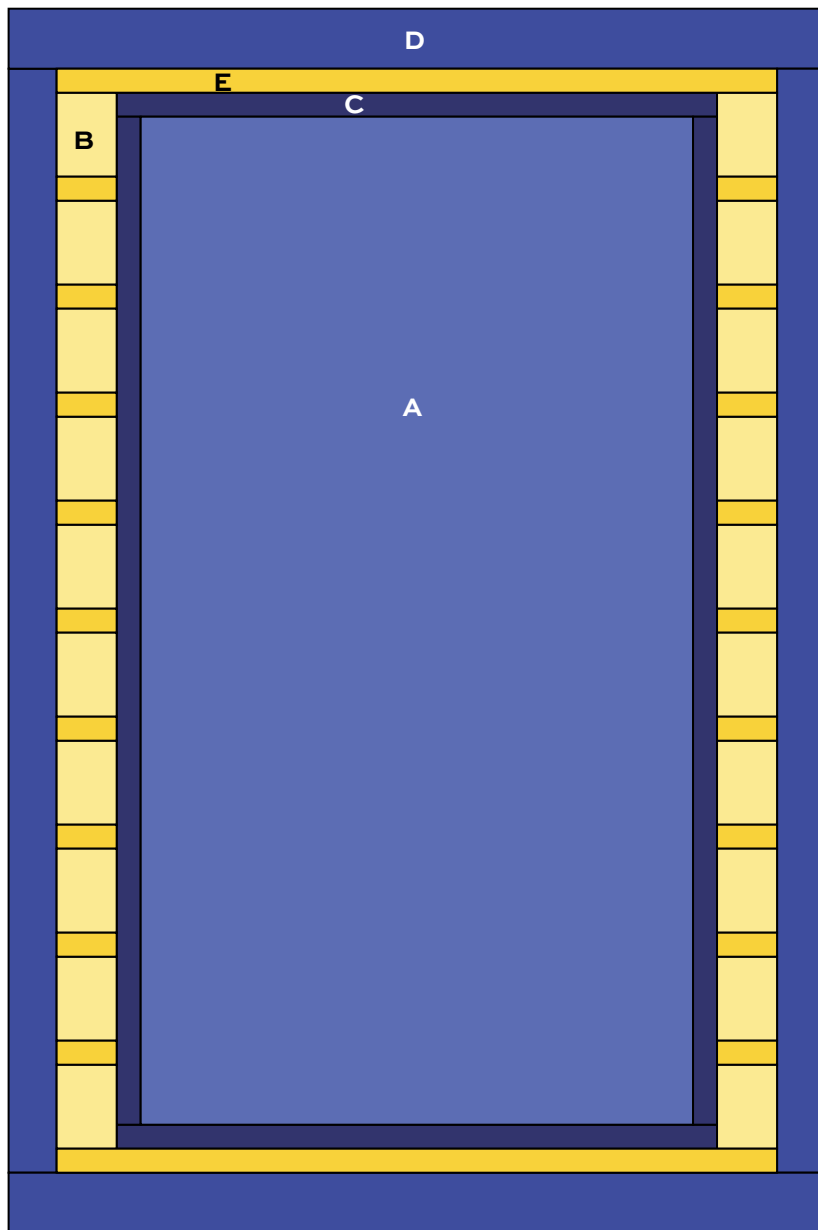
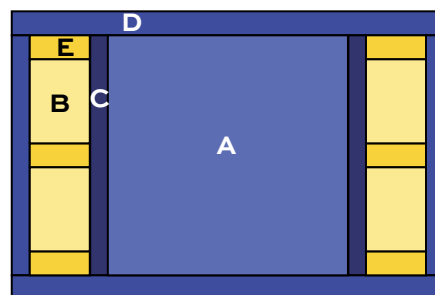


Table Runner Assembly
