Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A Cut (3) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric B Cut (1) 9 7/8" square.

Fabric C Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric D Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric E Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric F Cut (2) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (7) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric G Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric H Cut (1) 9 7/8" square.

Fabric I Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric J Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric K Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric L Cut (1) 9 7/8" square.

Fabric M Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric N Cut (3) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric O Cut (3) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (11) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric P Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric Q	Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric R	Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric S	Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric T	Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric U	Cut (1) 9 7/8" square.
Fabric V	Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric W	Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric X	Cut (2) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (7) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric Y	Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric Z	Cut (3) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric AA	Cut (2) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric BB	Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric CC	Cut (3) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (9) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric DD	Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric EE	Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.
Fabric FF	Cut (1) 9 7/8" square.
Fabric GG	Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric HH Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric II Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.

Fabric JJ Cut (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 7/8" squares.

Binding Cut (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

Backing Cut (2) 80" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 80" x 80" backing.

Making the Quilt

Note: *The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.*

1. Block Assembly

Place (1) 9 7/8" Fabric X square on top of (1) 9 7/8" Fabric Z square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 9 1/2" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Diagram 3).

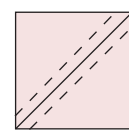

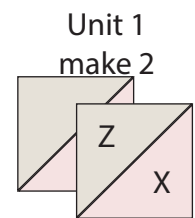

2. Place (1) 9 7/8" Fabric R square on top of (1) 9 7/8" Fabric O square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 4). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 4). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 5) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 9 1/2" square to make (2) Unit 2 squares (Diagram 6). *Note: Only (1) Unit 2 will be used.*

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3. Repeat Steps 1 and refer to the Quilt Layout for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make the designated 9 1/2" unit squares. *Note: You should have (64) squares to make the quilt top.*

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

4. Sew together (8) assorted 9 1/2" unit squares to make Row One.

5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to the Quilt Layout to make Row Two through Row Eight.

6. Sew together the (8) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to bottom, to make the quilt top.

Finishing the Quilt

7. Layer and quilt as desired.

8. Sew the (8) binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

9. Bind as desired.

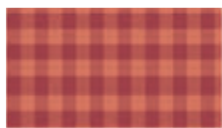
