



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- 3. Repeat Steps 1 and refer to the Quilt Layout for fabric 7. Layer and quilt as desired. identification, placement and seam direction to make the designated 9 1/2" unit squares. Note: You should have (64) squares to make the quilt top.
- **Quilt Top Assembly**


(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.) 9.

4. Sew together (8) assorted 9 ½" unit squares to make Row One.

- 5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to the Quilt Layout to make Row Two through Row Eight.
- **6.** Sew together the (8) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to bottom, to make the quilt top.

Finishing the Quilt

- 8. Sew the (8) binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- Bind as desired.



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


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Bolts needed to cut project kits: 15 yds = 1 bolt
