

Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A	Cut (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ "
	squares.

Fabric B	Cut (7) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips and (8) 2 ½'
	squares

Fabric C	Cut (4) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut
	the strips into (40) $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
	Cut (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut
	the strips into (96) 2 ½" squares.

Fabric D	Cut (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ "
	squares.

Fabric E	Cut (4) $2 \frac{1}{8}$ " squares and (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ "
	squares.

Fabric F	Cut (9) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

Fabric G	Cut (2) 3 3/8" squares and (8) 2 1/2"
	squares. Cut the 3 3/8" squares

Fabric H	Cut (1) 3 % x WOF strip. Sub-cut
	the strip into $(4) 3 \frac{3}{4}$ " squares

make (16) 3 ¾" triangles. Cut the 3 ¾" squares across one diagonal to make (8) 3 ¾" triangles.
Cut (9) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut

Cut (9) $3\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ x $6\frac{1}{2}$ strips, (88) $3\frac{1}{2}$ squares and (2) $3\frac{3}{8}$ squares.

Cut (7) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (80) 2 1/8" squares.

Cut (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding. Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 42 ½" strips.

Cut (11) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18" strips and (119) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Cut (11) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (76) 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (76) 2" squares.

Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 42 ½" strips.

Cut (7) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 1 ½" x 5 ½"strips, (4) 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips and (68) 1 ½" x 2 ½" strips.

Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued

Fabric I Cut (5) 3 ½" squares, (4) 2 ½" squares and (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric J Cut (5) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips and (8) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric K Cut (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (40) 2" squares.

Fabric L Cut (5) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips and (8) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric M Cut (7) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips and (8) 2 ½" squares.

Fabric N Cut (40) 2" squares.

Fabric O Cut (4) 2 1/8" squares and (2) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric P Cut (5) 3 1/2" squares and (8) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric Q Cut (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (2) 2 ½" squares.

Fabric R Cut (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and (72) 2" squares.

Fabric S Cut (4) 2 1/8" squares and (2) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric T Cut (2) 3 3/8" squares, (4) 2 1/8" squares, (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Cut the $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares across one diagonal to make (4) 3 3/8" triangles.

Fabric U Cut (2) $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares, (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, (5) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips and (2) 2 ½" squares.

Fabric V Cut (8) 2 1/2" squares.

Fabric W Cut (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (2) 2 ½" squares.

Fabric X Fussy cut (4) 18 1/2" wide x 18" high rectangles centered on the motif.

Backing Cut (2) 74" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 74" x 80" backing.

Making the Quilt

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Block Assembly

Place (1) 2" Fabric R square on the left side of (1) 2" x 3 1/2" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Diagram 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Diagram 2).

- **2.** Place (1) 2" Fabric R square on the right side of the 2" x 3 1/2" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Diagram 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Diagram 4).
- **3.** Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (36) Unit 1 strips.

4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagrams 5-6 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (20) Unit 2 strips and (20) Unit 3 strips.





5. Sew (1) 2" Fabric H square to each side of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric F square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows to make (1) 6 ½" Block One square (Diagram 7). Repeat to make (9) Block One squares.



Repeat Step 5 and refer to Diagrams 8-9 for fabric/ unit identification, placement and orientation to make (5) Block Two squares and (5) Block Three squares.




7. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric H square on the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Diagram 10). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 10). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Diagram 11).






8. Place another 2 1/2" Fabric H square on the right side of the 2½" x 4½" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Diagram 12). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 12). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Diagram 13).


9. Repeat Steps 7-8 to make (7) Unit 4 strips.




10. Repeat Steps 7-8 and refer to Diagrams 14-21 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make the indicated number of unit strips for Unit 5 through Unit 12.



11. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and bottom of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the left column. Sew (1) 2½" Fabric H square to the top of (1) Unit 5 strip to make the center column. Sew (1) 11/2" x 21/2" Fabric H strip to the top and bottom of (1) Unit 6 strip to make the right column. Sew together the (3) columns to make (1) 6 1/2" Block Four square (Diagram 22). Repeat to make (7) Block Four squares.



12. Repeat Step 11 and refer to Diagrams 23-24 for fabric/unit identification, placement and orientation to make (5) Block Five squares and (5) Block Six squares.





13. Place (1) 2 1/8" Fabric H square on top of (1) 2 1/8" Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 25). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 25). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 26) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 1/2" to make (2) Unit 13 squares (Diagram 27). Repeat to make (80) Unit 13 squares.

14. Repeat Step 13 and refer to Diagrams 28-37 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make the indicated number of unit squares for Unit 14 through Unit 23.



15. Sew (1) Unit 13 square to each side of (1) Unit 14 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 14 square to each side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows to make (1) 6 ½" Block Seven square (Diagram 38). Repeat to make a second Block Seven square.




16. Repeat Step 15 and refer to Diagrams 39-47 for fabric/unit identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of block squares for Block Eight through Block Sixteen.








17. Place (1) 3 %" Fabric H square on top of (1) 3 %"
Fabric U square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 48). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 48). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 49) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3" to make (2) Unit 24 squares

(Diagram 50). Repeat to make (4) Unit 24 squares.

18. Sew (1) 3 ¾" Fabric H triangle to the top and right side of (1) Unit 24 square to make (1) Unit 25 piece (Diagram 51). Repeat to make (4) Unit 25 pieces.



19. Sew (1) 3 3/8" Fabric G triangle to the top right of (1) Unit 25 piece to make (1) Unit 26 piece (Diagram 52). Repeat to make (4) Unit 26 pieces total.

20. Sew (1) 3 ³4" Fabric H triangle to the top and right side of (1) Unit 26 piece to make (1) Unit 27 piece (Diagram 53). Repeat to make (4) Unit 27 pieces.



21. Sew (2) 3 3/8" Fabric H triangles and (1) 3 3/8" Fabric T triangle as shown to (1) Unit 27 piece to make (1) Unit 28 square (Diagram 54). Trim the unit to measure 5 1/2" square. Repeat to make (4) Unit 28 squares.



22. Sew (1) 1½" x 5½" Fabric H strip to the top of (1) Unit 28 square. Sew (1) 1½" x 6½" Fabric H strip to the right side of (1) Unit 28 square to make (1) 6½" Block Seventeen square (Diagram 55). Repeat to make (4) Block Seventeen squares.



23. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric C square on the top left corner of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric H square, right sides together (Diagram 56). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 56). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Diagram 57).

- **24.** Follow Diagram 58 for the seam direction to add (1) 21/2" Fabric G square to the bottom right corner of the 3½" Fabric H square to make (1) Unit 29 square (Diagram 59).
- 25. Repeat Steps 23-24 to make (8) Unit 29 squares.

27. Sew together (4) Unit 29 squares into a 2 x 2 matrix to make (1) 6 1/2" Block Eighteen square (Diagram 70). Repeat to make a second Block Eighteen square.





- **29.** Sew together (3) 2 ½" x 18" Fabric H strips and (2) 18 ½" x 18" Fabric X rectangles alternating them from left to right. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and bottom of the newly sewn strip to make the top row (Diagram 81). Repeat to make the bottom row.
- **30.** Sew together (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric H strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Four square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Five square, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Six square and (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric H strip, alternating them from left to right, to make the middle row (Diagram 81).
- **31.** Sew together the top row, (1) 2" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip, the middle row, (1) 2" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip and the bottom row, in that order from top to bottom, to make the 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block (Diagram 81).



32. Sew together (8) assorted block squares as shown to make the 6 ½" x 48 ½" Inner Left Side Border (Diagram 82). Repeat to make the Inner Right Side Border (Diagram 83).




33. Sew together (9) assorted block squares as shown to make the 6½" x 54½" Inner Top Border (Diagram 84). Repeat to make the Inner Bottom Border (Diagram 85).





34. Sew together (10) assorted block squares as shown to make the 6½" x 60½" Outer Left Side Border (Diagram 86). Repeat to make the Outer Right Side Border (Diagram 87).



35. Sew together (11) assorted block squares as shown to make the 6½" x 66½" Outer Top Border (Diagram 88). Repeat to make the Outer Bottom Border (Diagram 89).


Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- **36.** Sew the Inner Left Side Border and Inner Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block. Sew the Inner Top Border and Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- **37.** Sew the Outer Left Side Border and Outer Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the 66 ½" x 72 ½" quilt top.

Finishing the Quilt

- 38. Layer and quilt as desired.
- **39.** Sew the (8) Fabric H binding strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 40. Bind as desired.


