Friendship Quilt

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: Heartland by Judy Jarvi. Quilt designed by Judy Jarvi

Quilt finishes 60" x60" 25 Blocks: 12" x 12"

Lovely stripes, florals, wheelbarrows, and a country farm scene lend interest to this throw-size quilt made with original pieced blocks. The piecing is easy enough that you might make more than one to honor your friendships.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include ¼" seam allowances. A fat ½ is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. A fat ¼ is an 18" x 20"-22" cut. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Cutting for ONE Block Fabric 17:

Cut (2) rectangles 2½" x 6½" Cut (2) rectangles 2½" x 4½" Cut (2) squares 4½"

Medium Print:

Cut (1) rectangle 2½" x 6½" Cut (1) rectangle 2½" x 4½" Cut (4) squares 2½"

Light Print:

Cut (1) rectangle 2½" x 6½" Cut (1) rectangle 2½" x 4½" Cut (4) squares 2½"

Cutting for ENTIRE Quilt Fabric 17

Cut (50) rectangles $2\%'' \ge 6\%''$ Cut (50) rectangles $2\%'' \ge 4\%''$ Cut (50) squares 4%''

Fabric 18 Cut patches for (1) block

Fabric 20

Cut (7) strips 2½" x WOF for binding Cut patches for 2 blocks

5 Prints From each: Cut patches for (3) blocks

16 Fat ¹/₈ From each: Cut patches for (2) blocks

Backing

Cut (2) lengths 36" x 70", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Making the Quilt

When making the blocks, refer to these labels and the list of fabrics on the last page of the pattern.

Making the Quilt

 Choose 2 fabrics (plus Fabric 17) for a block, referring to the Block diagrams for combinations. Sew a medium 2¹/₂" square to a light 2¹/₂" square. Press seam allowances toward the medium fabric. Repeat. Sew the 2 pieced

rectangles together to make a checkerboard square (Diagram 1). Press the seam allowance in one direction or open. The unit should measure 4½" square. Repeat to make a second checkerboard.

2. Arrange the checkerboards with the other patches into 4 horizontal rows (Diagram 2). Be careful to rotate the checkerboards as shown. Join the patches into rows. Press seam allowances toward Fabric 17 patches. Join the rows. The block should measure 12½" from edge to edge. If it does not, adjust your piecing and pressing techniques.







- **3.** Repeat these steps to make the blocks in the numbers shown. Make a total of 25 blocks.
- **4.** Refer to the Quilt Assembly. Arrange the blocks into 5 rows of 5 blocks each. Stand back to be sure that they are in the order you prefer. Look through a camera to be certain all are rotated in the correct position. Once you are satisfied, join the blocks into rows. Press seam allowances in alternating rows in opposite directions. Finally, join the rows.

Finishing the Quilt

5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around patches. Quilt the Fabric 17 patches as you wish. Or, quilt an overall design. Bind to finish the quilt.



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Quilt Assembly

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All fabrics are used in quilt pattern. Fabrics shown are 50% of actual size.



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
