Mocha Quilt

*Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: Mocha by The Henley Studio for Makower UK
Quilt designed by Heidi Pridemore*

Quilt finishes 56" x 56"
Blocks: 6" square

Cutting Directions

Note: Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus ¼" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Mocha Panel

Fussy cut (9) cup blocks ¼" outside the printed lines.

Mocha Stripe

Fussy cut (4) 5½" x 60" strips on the same motif from LOF.

Cream Cups

Cut (2) 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (8) 6½" squares.

Brown Cups

Cut (2) 6½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (12) 6½" squares.

Brown Words

Fussy cut (4) 1½" x 16½" strips with the printed words running along the length of the strip.

Brown Beans

Cut one 6½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (4) 2½" x 6½" strips, (4) 2½" x 4½" strips and (4) 2½" squares.

Cut (2) 5½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (36) 1½" x 5½" strips.

Tan Beans

Cut (1) 4½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (12) 1½" x 4½" strips.

Cut (2) 1½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (4) 1½" x 16½" strips.

Cut (2) 6½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (20) 2½" x 6½" strips

Cut one 2½" x WOF. Sub-cut into (4) 2½" x 4½" strips and (4) 2½" squares.

Red Dots

Cut (8) 2½" x WOF strips Piece the strips together to make four 2½" x 60" strips.

Cut (1) 1½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (4) 1½" squares.

Tan Swirls

Cut (1) 6½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (12) 2½" x 6½" strips.

Cut (1) 4½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (4) 2½" x 4½" strips and (4) 2½" squares.

Cream Dots

Cut (1) 6½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (8) 2½" x 6½" strips, (4) 2½" x 4½" strips and (4) 2½" squares.

Brown Dots

Cut (6) 2½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Backing

Cut (2) 64" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make one 64" x 64" square backing.

Mocha Quilt

Center Section

1. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " brown beans strip to each side of one mocha panel square. Trim the side borders even with the top of the mocha panel square. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " brown beans strip to the top and bottom of the mocha panel square (Fig. 1). Trim the Mocha block to measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make nine $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " mocha blocks (Fig. 3).




FIG. 4 – make 3

2. Sew together three mocha blocks and four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " tan beans strip to make one pieced row (Fig. 4). Repeat to make three pieced rows.
3. Sew together the three pieced rows and four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " tan beans strips, alternating them to make the $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " center block (Fig. 5).
4. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " brown words strip to each side of the center block (Fig. 5).
5. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " red dots square to each end of the remaining two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " brown words strips to make the top and bottom borders. Sew the border the center block to make the $18\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " quilt top center (Fig. 5).

Pieced Blocks




FIG. 6 – make 4

6. Sew one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " tan swirls strip to the top and bottom of one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " brown beans strip to make one $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square Brown Beans Unit (Fig. 6). Repeat to make four brown beans units total.




FIG. 7 – make 8

7. Sew one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " tan beans strip to the top and bottom of one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " cream dots strip to make one $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square cream dots unit (Fig. 7). Repeat to make eight cream dots units total.




FIG. 8 – make 4

8. Sew together the following tan swirls pieces; one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strip along with the following brown beans pieces; one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make one brown beans corner unit (Fig. 8). Repeat to make four brown beans corner units total.




FIG. 9 – make 4

9. Sew together the following Tan Beans pieces; one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strip along with the following cream dots pieces; one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make one cream dots corner unit (Fig. 9). Repeat to make four cream dots corner units total.





Mocha Quilt

Quilt Top

Refer to the quilt layout (Fig. 10) and quilt photo to assemble.

10. Sew together two $6\frac{1}{2}$ " cream cups squares and one brown beans unit, alternating them to make one brown beans border. Repeat to make four brown beans borders total.
11. Sew one brown beans border to each side of the quilt top center.
12. Sew one brown beans corner unit to each end of the remaining two brown beans borders to make the top and bottom borders. Sew the borders to the quilt top.
13. Sew together three $6\frac{1}{2}$ " brown cups squares and two cream dots units, alternating them to make one cream dots border. Repeat to make four cream dots borders total.
14. Sew one cream dots border to each side of the quilt top.
15. Sew one cream dots corner unit to each end of the remaining two cream dots borders to make the top and bottom borders. Sew the borders to the quilt top to make the $42\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " quilt top.
16. Sew one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60" red dots strip to the bottom of each $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60" mocha stripe strips to make the four $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60" border strips.
17. Center one $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60" border strip on one side of the quilt top with the red dots edge aligned with the quilt top. Start sewing the strip a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top edge of the quilt top and stop a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
18. Repeat Step 17 to sew one $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top, making sure to stop and start $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the quilt top.
19. To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 11) draw a 45° line out to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to complete the 56 " x 56 " square top.





Finishing the Quilt

20. Layer and quilt as desired. Sew the six $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" brown dots strips together end-to-end with a 45° seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Bind as desired.






