

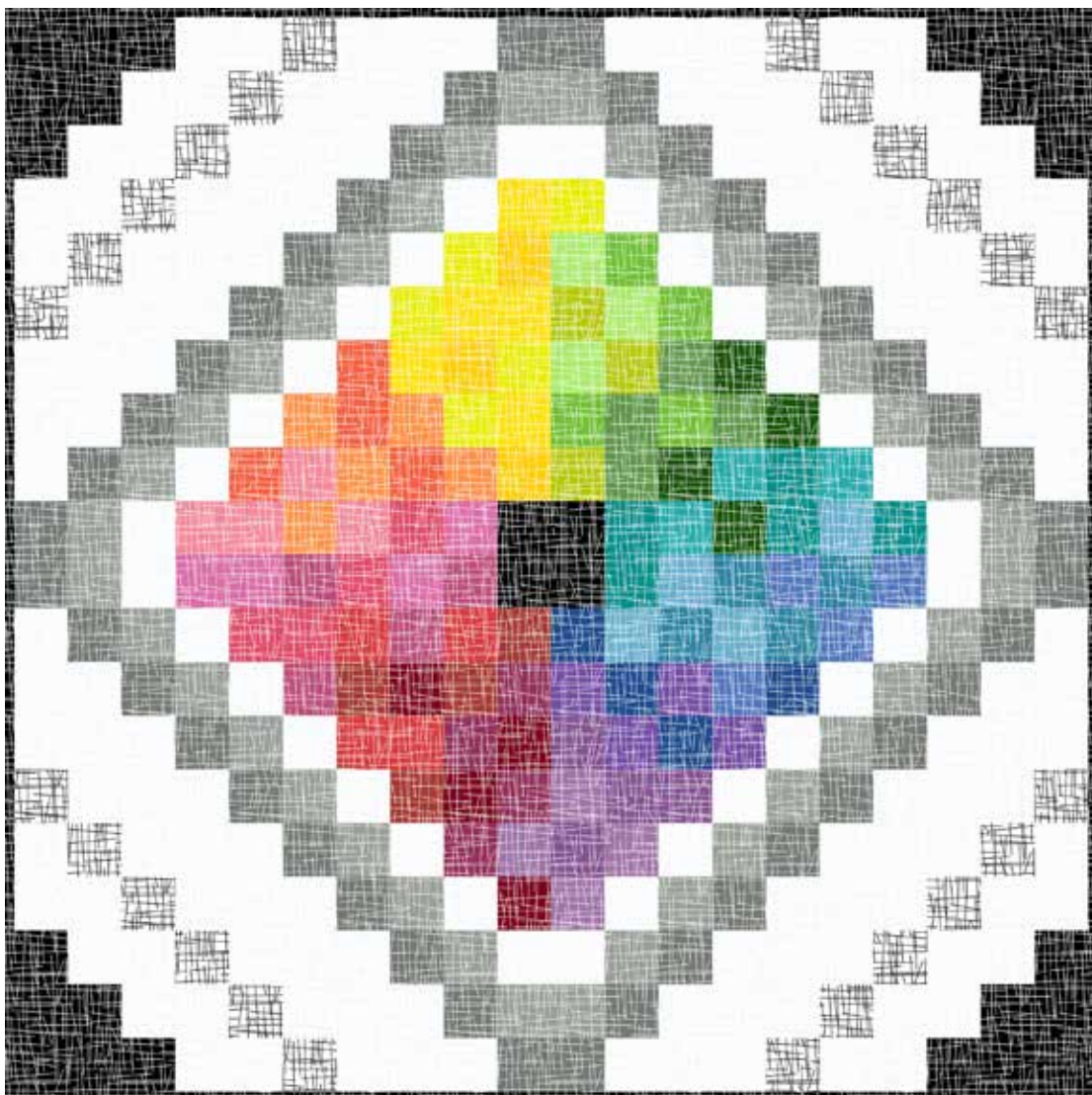

*This updated variation of the familiar Trip Around the World design makes a stunning wall quilt that is so very simple to make. The fun will be in arranging the squares to make the quilt uniquely your own.*

## Cutting Directions

**Note:** Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include 1/4" seam allowances. A fat 1/8 is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

### Fabric A

Cut (40) squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

### Fabric B

Cut (36) squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

### Fabric C

Cut (7) strips 2 1/2" x WOF for binding

Cut (28) squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

### Fabric D

Cut (164) squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

### Fabric E

Cut (24) squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

**27 Brights** From each:

Cut (2-6) squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" (108 total)

Read Step 1 before cutting squares.

### Backing

Cut (2) panels 34" x 68", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Quilt

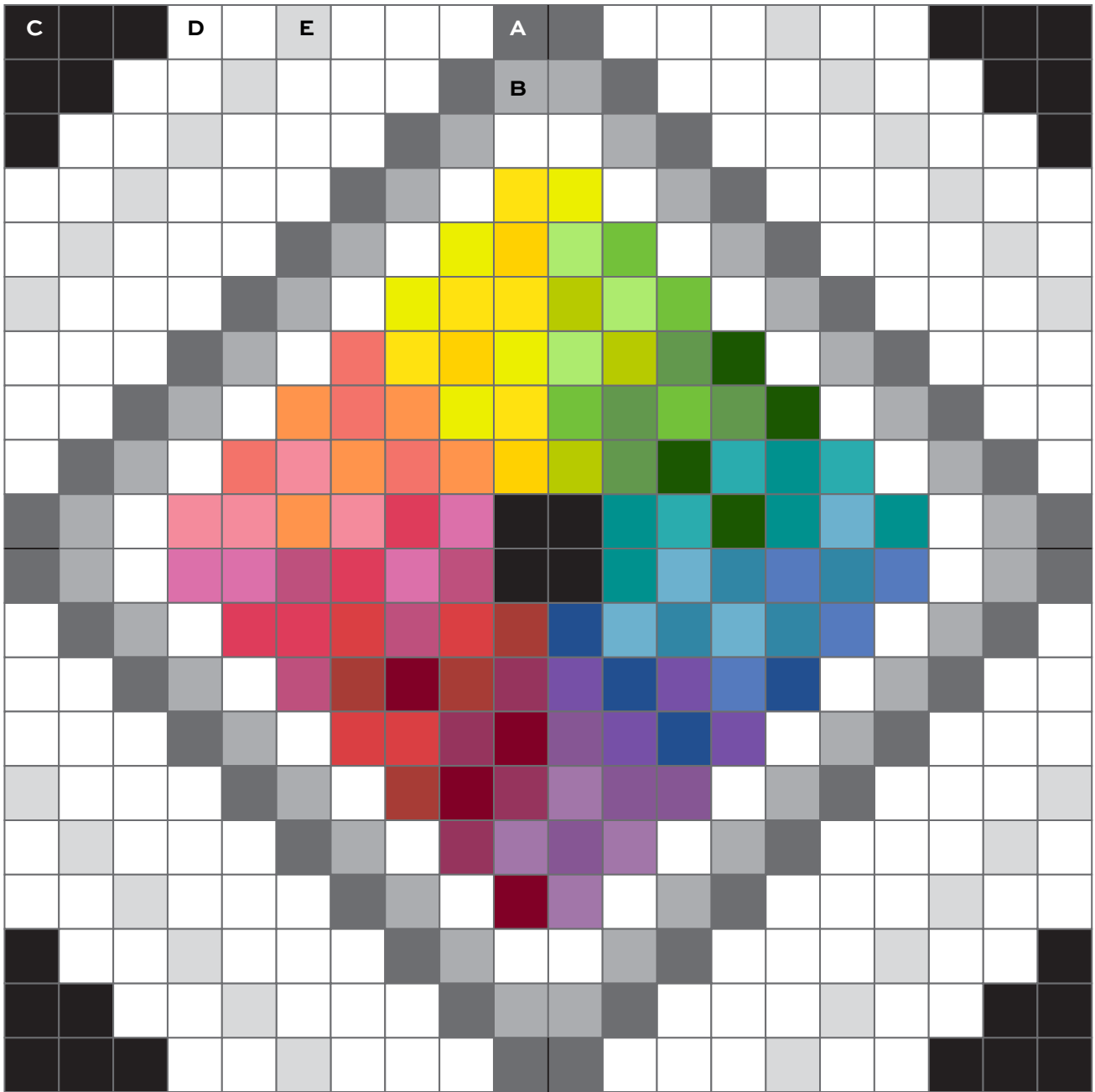
1. Referring to the quilt diagram, count the number of squares from each bright fabric and cut that number. Or if you prefer, cut 4 from each of the 27 brights for a total of 108 squares.
2. On a flat surface, arrange the squares in 20 rows of 20 squares each, being careful to follow the design for the placement of Fabrics A-E. Place the bright squares around the center as you wish. (Note that the brights are arranged in "rainbow" order.) Join the squares into rows, and then join the rows.

## Finishing the Quilt

3. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around the squares. Bind to finish the quilt.
