## Quilt Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.** Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

**Fabric A** Refer to Diagram 1 to cut (12) Template 1 triangles and (8) Template 2 triangles from each of (24) Fat 1/4's. *You should end with (288) Template 1 triangles and (192) Template 2 triangles.* Divide the Template 1 triangles into (63) sets of (4) matching prints. *Use will only use (252) Template 1 triangles.* Divide the Template 2 triangles into (31) sets of (4) matching prints. *You will only use (94) Template 2 triangles.*

Fat Quarter Cutting Diagram

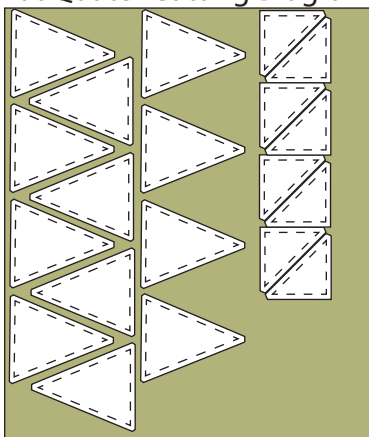

**Fabric B** Cut (16) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (252) Template 1 triangles.  
Cut (6) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (124) Template 2 triangles.

## Fabric Requirements

Quilt	Yardage	Fabric
<b>Fabric A</b> blocks	(24) Fat 1/4 or (1) Quiltessentials Fat 1/4 bundle	
<b>Fabric B</b> background	3 1/8 yards	1674-L
<b>Fabric C</b> borders	1 1/4 yards	1679-C
<b>Binding</b>	2/3 yard	1672-T
<b>Backing</b>	5 1/2 yards	

**Fabric C** Cut (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 81 1/2" strips.  
Cut (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 71 1/2" strips.

**Binding** Cut (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

**Backing** Cut (2) 97" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 79" x 97" backing.

## Making the Quilt

**Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.**

1. **Block Assembly**  
Sew (1) Fabric A Template 2 triangle to the short side of (1) Fabric B Template 1 triangle to make (1) Unit 1 segment (Diagram 2). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 segments total using the same color for the Template 2 triangle.

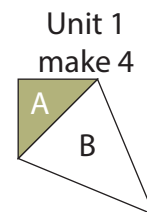

2. Sew (1) Fabric A Template 1 triangle to the long side of (1) Unit 1 segment to make (1) Unit 2 piece (Diagram 3). The Template 1 triangle should match the color of the Template 2 triangle used in Step 1. Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 pieces total.

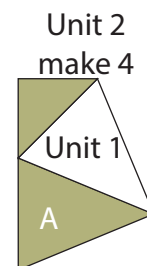

# Color Way

- Refer to Diagram 4 and sew together (4) matching Unit 2 pieces to make (1) Block One square. The block should measure 9 1/2" square.

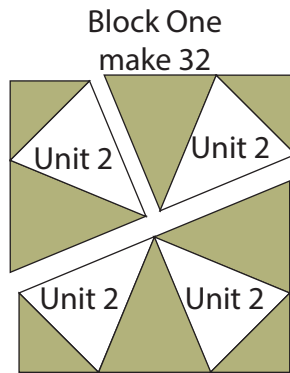

- Repeat Steps 1-3 to make (32) Block One squares total.

- Sew (1) Fabric B Template 2 triangle to the short side of (1) Fabric A Template 1 triangle to make (1) Unit 3 segment (Diagram 5). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 segments total using the same color for the Template 1 triangle.

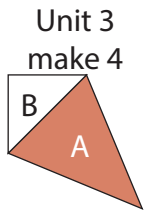

- Sew (1) Fabric B Template 1 triangle to the long side of (1) Unit 1 segment to make (1) Unit 4 piece (Diagram 6). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 pieces total.

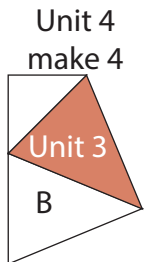

- Refer to Diagram 7 and sew together (4) matching Unit 2 pieces to make (1) Block One square. The block should measure 9 1/2" square.

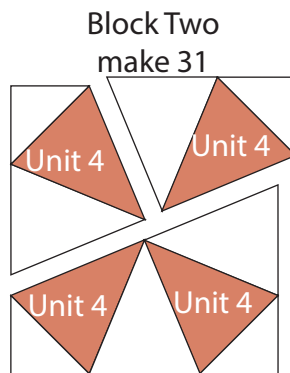

- Repeat Steps 5-7 to make (31) Block Two squares total.

- Sew together (4) Block One squares and (3) Block Two squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Diagram 8). Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five, Row Seven and Row Nine.

- Sew together (4) Block Two squares and (3) Block One squares, alternating them from left to right to make Row Two (Diagram 8). Repeat to make Row Four, Row Six, Row Eight.

- Sew together the (9) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to bottom, to make the 63 1/2" x 81 1/2" Center Block (Diagram 8).

## Quilt Top Assembly

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)*

- Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 81 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.

- Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 71 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

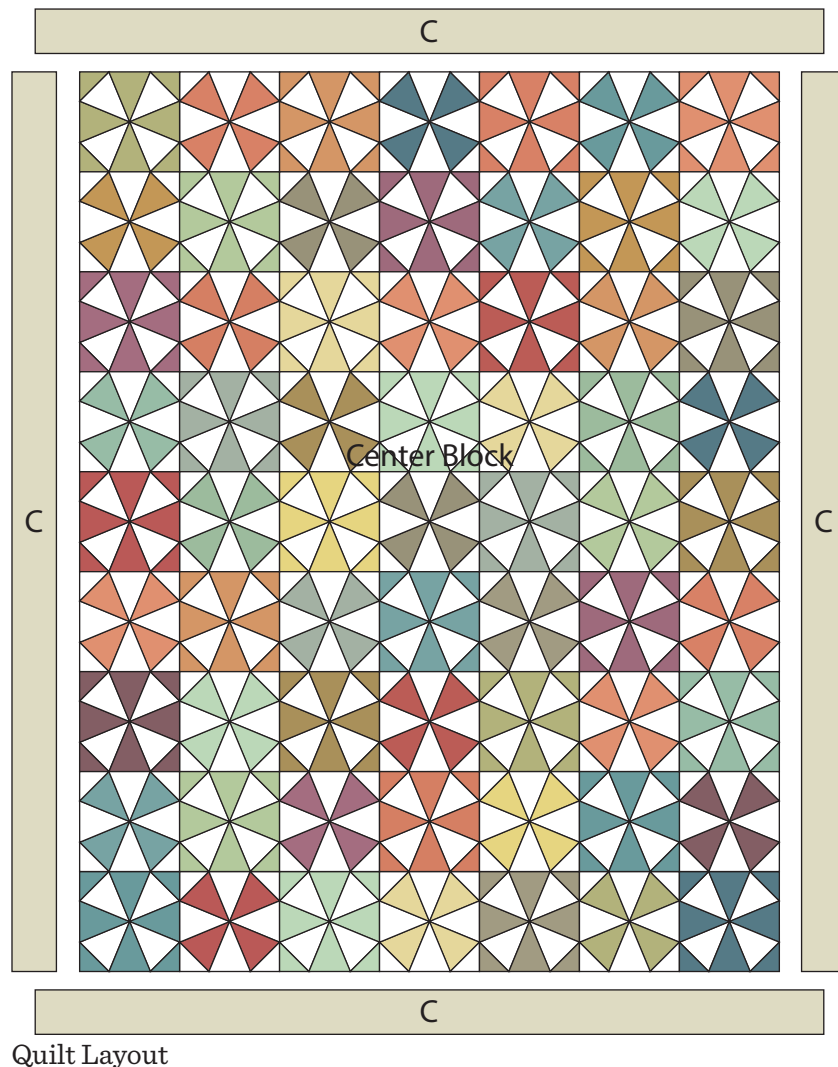

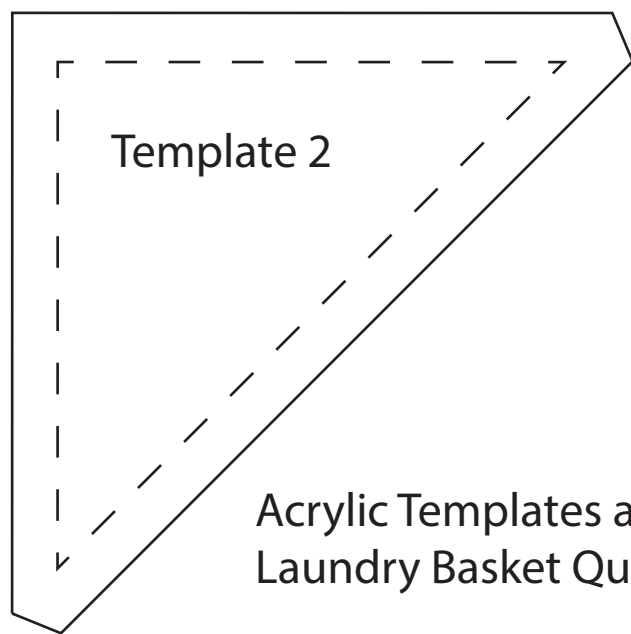
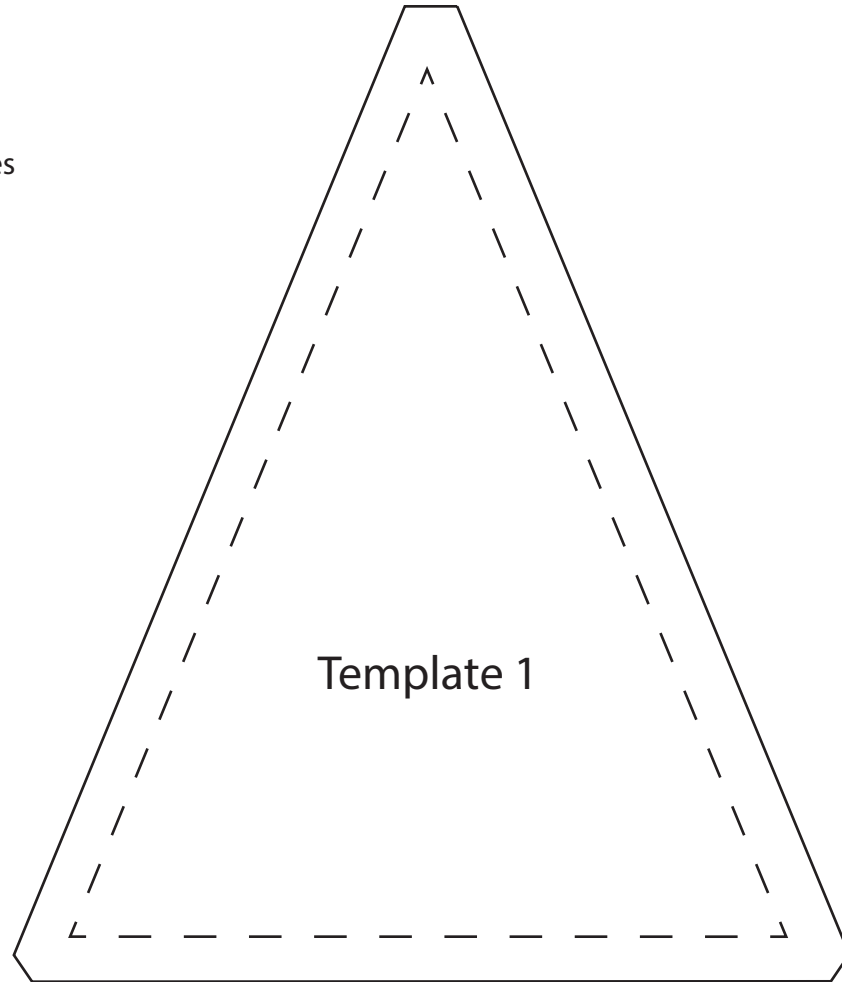
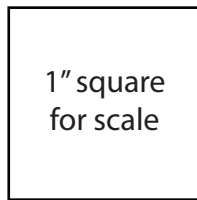
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### Finishing the Quilt

14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (8) binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.

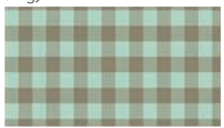
