

The bright circles in each block add extra sparkle. The 12" blocks require only 8 patches and are quick to piece. What a fun look for any kid's room.

Cutting Directions

Note: All measurements are cut sizes and include ½" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

- Fabric A Cut (2) squares 11½" x 11½", cut in half diagonally twice to make 8 quarter-square triangles

 Cut (8) strips 1½" x 12½"

 Cut (8) strips 1½" x 10½"
- Fabric B Cut (2) squares 11½" x 11½", cut in half diagonally twice to make 8 quarter-square triangles

 Cut (2) strips 1½" x 12½"

 Cut (2) strips 1½" x 10½"
- Fabric C Cut (3) squares 11½" x 11½", cut in half diagonally twice to make 12 quarter-square triangles

 Cut (6) strips 1½" x 12½"

 Cut (6) strips 1½" x 10½"
- Fabric D Cut (2) squares 11¼" x 11¼", cut in half diagonally twice to make 5 quarter-square triangles
 Cut (4) strips 1½" x 12½"
 Cut (4) strips 1½" x 10½"
- Fabric E Cut (3) squares 11½" x 11½", cut in half diagonally twice to make 11 quarter-square triangles
 Cut (4) strips 1½" x 12½"
 Cut (4) strips 1½" x 10½"
- Fabric F Cut (4) squares 11¼" x 11¼", cut in half diagonally twice to make 13 quarter-square triangles

 Cut (6) strips 1½" x 12½"

 Cut (6) strips 1½" x 10½"
- Fabric G Cut (4) squares 11¼" x 11¼", cut in half diagonally twice to make 14 quarter-square triangles

 Cut (6) strips 1½" x 12½"

 Cut (6) strips 1½" x 10½"
- Fabric H Cut (8) strips 2½" x WOF for binding
 Cut (2) squares 11¼" x 11¼", cut in half diagonally
 twice to make 7 quarter-square triangles
 Cut (2) strips 1½" x 12½"
 Cut (2) strips 1½" x 10½"

Salt and Pepper Quilt

Fabric I Cut (2) squares 11½" x 11½", cut in half diagonally twice to make 8 quarter-square triangles

Cut (4) strips 1½" x 12½" Cut (4) strips 1½" x 10½"

Fabric J Cut (3) squares $11\frac{1}{4}$ " x $11\frac{1}{4}$ ", cut in half diagonally twice to make 12 quarter-square triangles

Cut (8 strips 1½" x 12½" Cut (8) strips 1½" x 10½"

Fabric K Cut (3) squares 11½" x 11½", cut in half diagonally twice to make 10 quarter-square triangles

Cut (8) strips 1½" x 12½" Cut (8) strips 1½" x 10½"

Fabric L Cut (3) squares 11½" x 11½", cut in half diagonally twice to make 12 quarter-square triangles

Cut (8) strips 1½" x 12½" Cut (8) strips 1½" x 10½"

Fabric M Cut (3) squares 11¼" x 11¼", cut in half diagonally twice to make 10 quarter-square triangles

Cut (2) strips 1½" x 12½" Cut (2) strips 1½" x 10½"

Fabric N Cut (3) squares 11¹/₄" x 11¹/₄", cut in half diagonally twice to make 10 quarter-square triangles

Cut (2) strips 1½" x 12½" Cut (2) strips 1½" x 10½"

7 Brights Cut (5) circles 3½" diameter from each


Backing Cut (2) panels 34" x 90", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Making and Assembling the Quilt


- 1. Note that the first 7 fabrics in the list above (Fabrics A-G) are light prints. The next 7 fabrics are dark prints. Refer to the Quilt Diagram and the photograph if you wish to duplicate the placement of prints, or feel free to combine the fabrics in any way you wish. Just be sure to keep dark fabrics together and light fabrics together in the block centers. Referring to the Block Y Diagram, sew together 4 dark 11½" quarter-square triangles to make a square. Sew light 10½" strips to sides of the square. Sew light 12½" strips to the top and bottom. Make 18 Block Y's. Likewise, make 17 Block Z's, reversing the light and dark placement. Hint: Fabric 5826-K triangles are used in both light and dark centers.
- 2. Prepare the circles for appliqué. Position a circle in the center of each block and fuse or baste in place. Finish the edges with a decorative machine stitch using contrasting thread, or use an invisible thread with a blind appliqué machine stitch.
- **3.** Referring to the Quilt Diagram, join 3 Block Y and 2 Block Z to make a horizontal row. Make 4 rows like this. Join 3 Block Z and 2 Block Y to make a row. Make 3 rows like this. Join the rows, alternating types.

Finishing the Quilt


4. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around the blocks and around the circles. Bind to finish the quilt.
