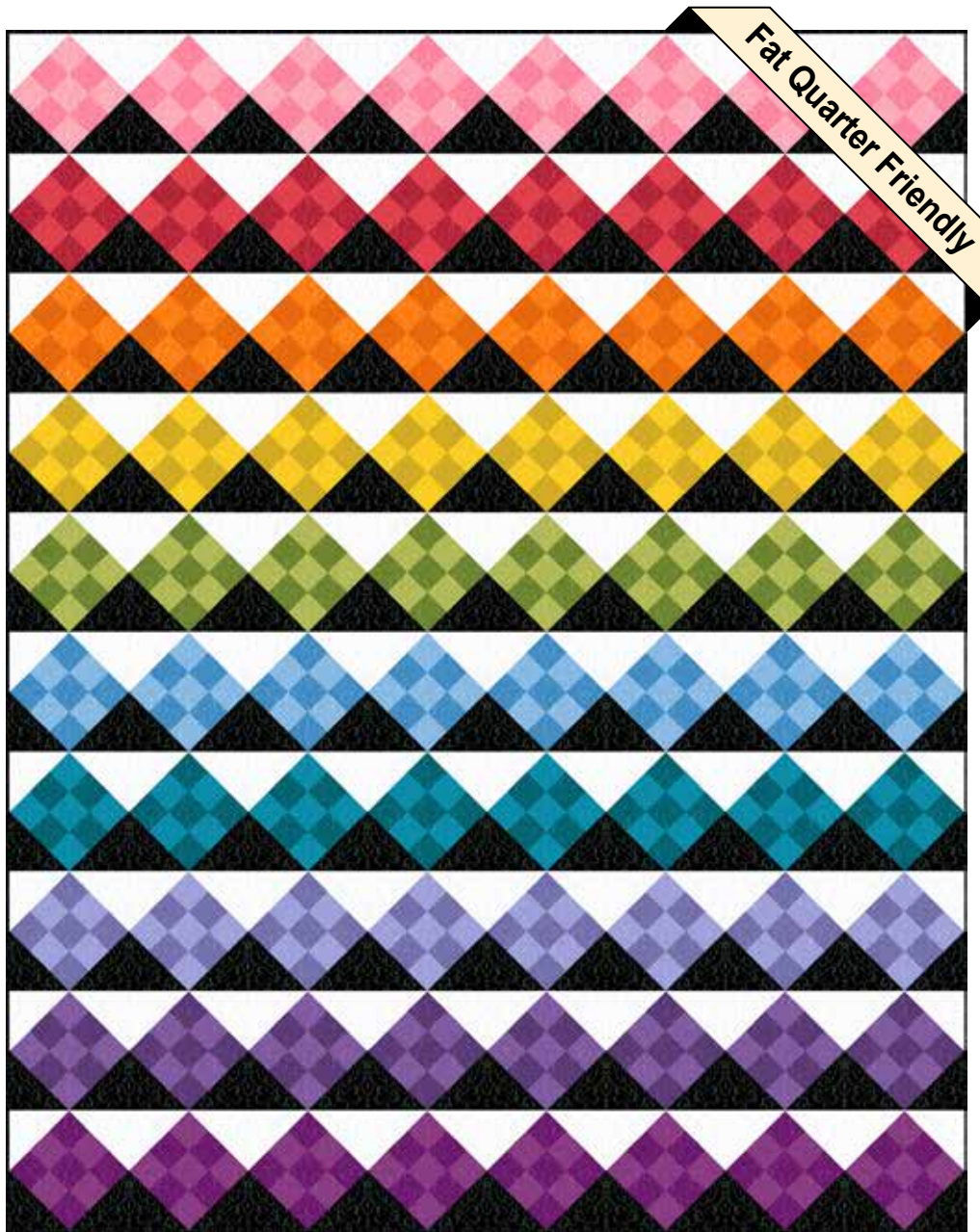

Quilt finishes 68" x 85"

80 Blocks: 8½" x 8½" finished

Stack the blocks in color-wheel order, or arrange them in any design that appeals to your creativity. Easy enough for a beginning quilter, this charming project is perfect for a twin-bed topper or throw.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include ¼" seam allowances. A fat ¼ is an 18" x 20"-22" cut. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A

Cut (80) squares 5½", cut in half diagonally to make 160 half-square triangles

Fabric B

Cut (8) strips 2½" x WOF for binding
Cut (80) squares 5½", cut in half diagonally to make 160 half-square triangles

20 Fat ¼s From each:

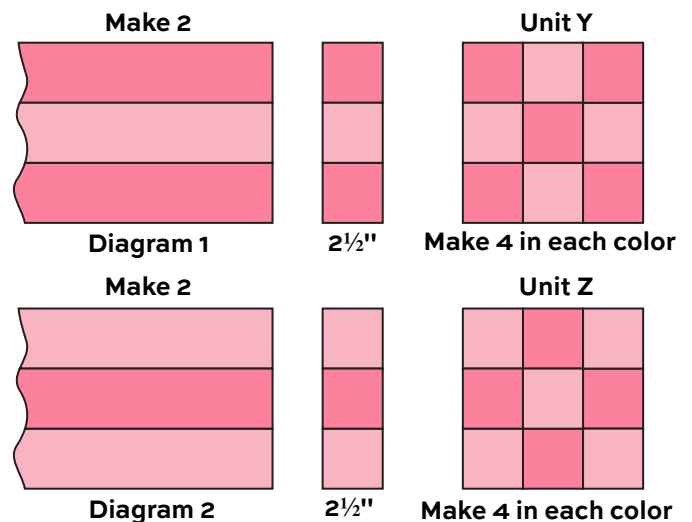
Cut (6) strips 2½" x 18"

Backing

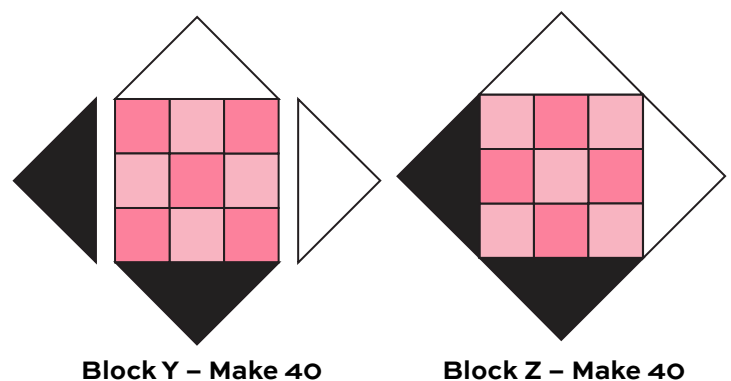
Cut (2) panels 37" x 90", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Making the Quilt

- The blocks are made with 10 different color combinations: In each combination, one fabric is lighter and one is darker of the same color. Refer to the Quilt Diagram to divide the 18" strips into 10 combinations. Sew a lighter strip between 2 darker strips to make a band (Diagram 1). Make 2 bands like this. Sew a darker strip between 2 lighter strips (Diagram 2). Make 2 bands like this. Press all seam allowances toward the darker fabric. Cut each band into 6 segments that are 2½" wide (12 segments of each kind). Repeat these steps with each of the 10 color combinations.



- Referring to the Unit Y and Unit Z diagrams, join the segments to make 4 of each kind of unit. Repeat these steps with each color combination.

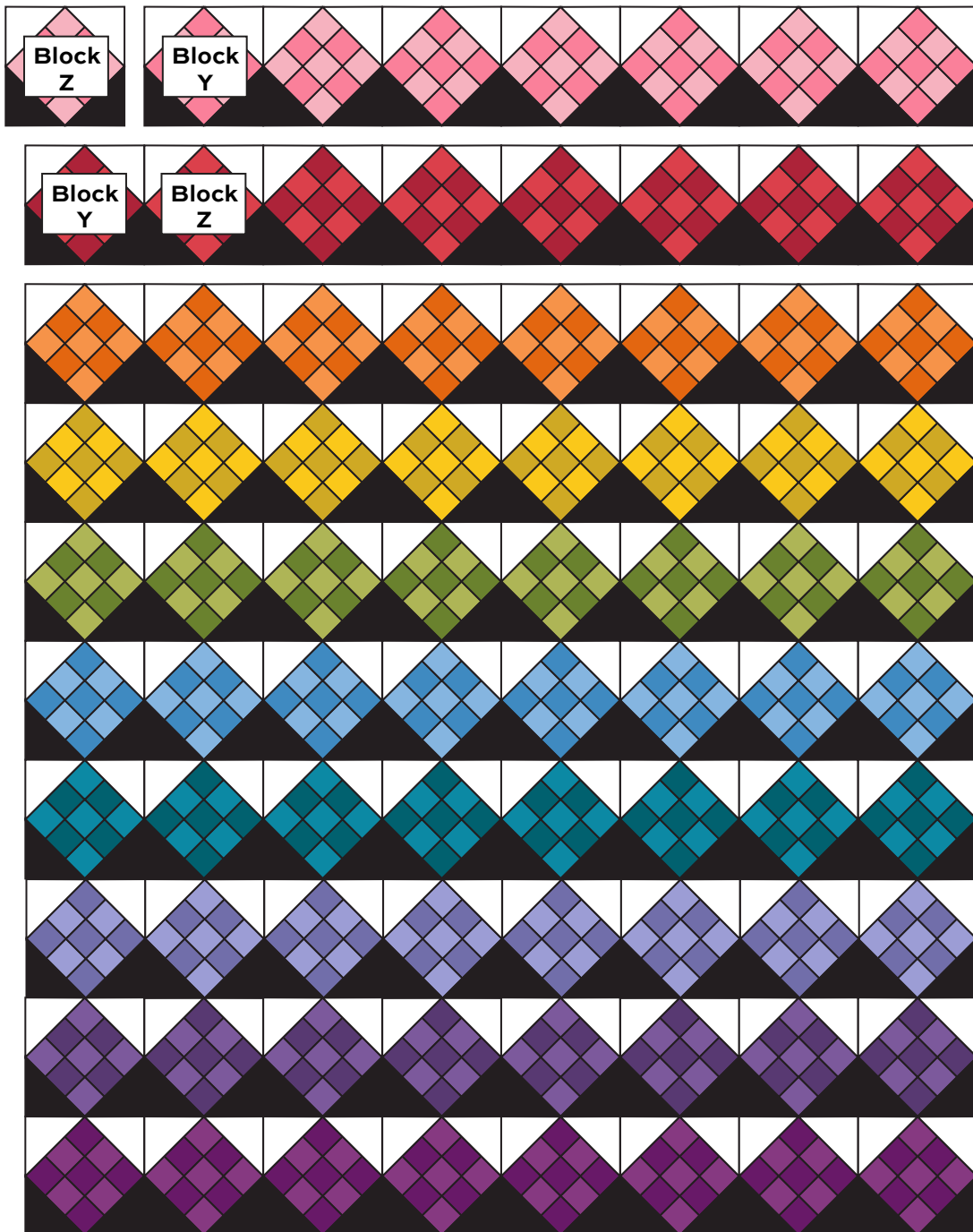

3. Sew 2 Fabric A triangles to adjacent sides of each unit. Sew Fabric B triangles to remaining sides as shown in the block diagrams. The block should measure 9" x 9". Make 40 Block Y and 40 Block Z.
4. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange the blocks in 10 rows of 8 blocks each, alternating Y and Z Blocks as shown. Join the blocks in rows, and then join the rows.

Finishing the Quilt

5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around block patches, or quilt an overall motif across the quilt. Bind to finish the quilt.
