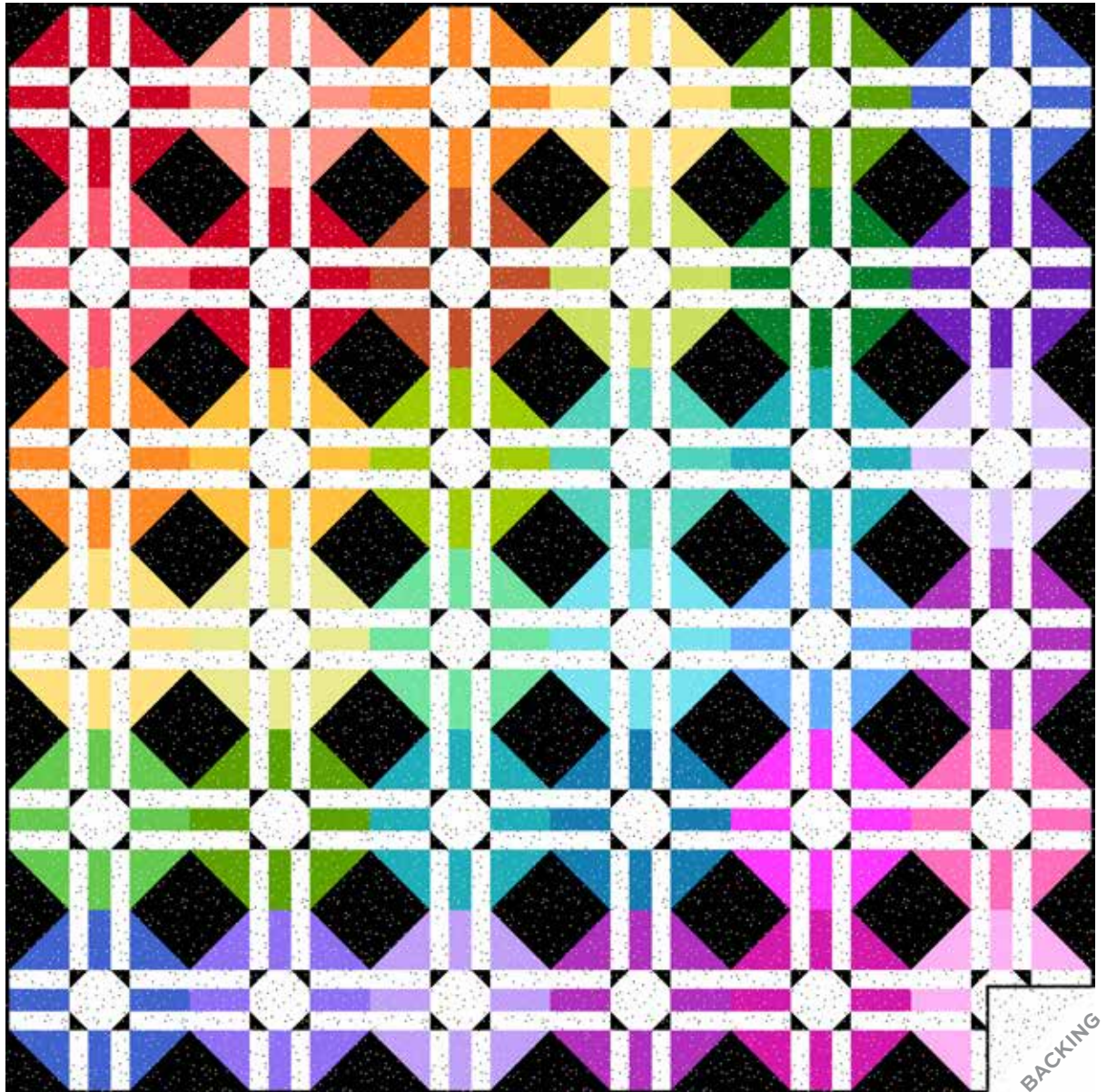

Quilt finishes 72" x 72"

36 Blocks: 12" x 12"

Black and white combine to illuminate the lovely jewel colors in this quilt topper. The piecing tricks the eye so that the edges of the blocks disappear. Are the white strips sashing and the black diamonds the blocks, or is something else happening? Part of the fun will be in arranging the colors to your liking.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include ¼" seam allowances.

Cutting for ONE Block

White (Fabric 31)

Cut (1) square 4½" for Center Unit

Cut (8) rectangles 1¾" x 4½" for Side Units

Black (Fabric 32)

Cut (2) squares 5" (or 4⅞") for HST (Read Step 2)

Cut (4) squares 1¾" for Center Units

Jewel Print

Cut (4) rectangles 2" x 4½" for Side Units

Cut (2) squares 5" (or 4⅞") for HST

Cutting for Entire Quilt

White

Cut (36) squares 4½" for Center Units

Cut (288) rectangles 1¾" x 4½" for Side Units

Black

Cut (72) squares 5" (or 4⅞") for HST (Read Step 2)

Cut (144) squares 1¾" for Center Units

29 Jewels

Cut patches for ONE block from each square
(Read Step 1)

Binding

Cut (8) strips 2½" x WOF for binding

Backing

Cut (2) lengths 41" x 82", pieced to fit quilt top
with overlap on all sides

Making the Quilt

When making the blocks, refer to these labels and the list of fabrics on the last page of the pattern.

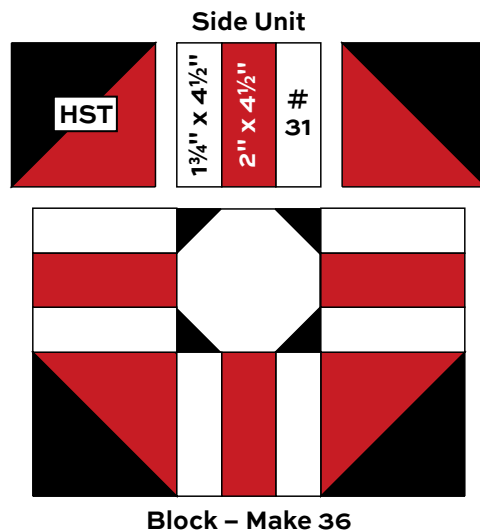
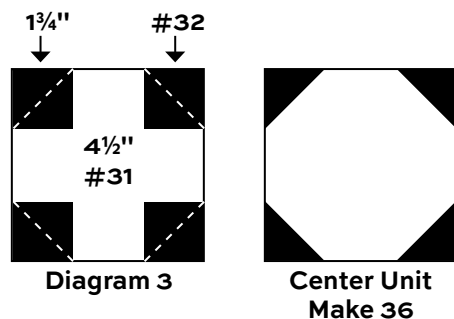
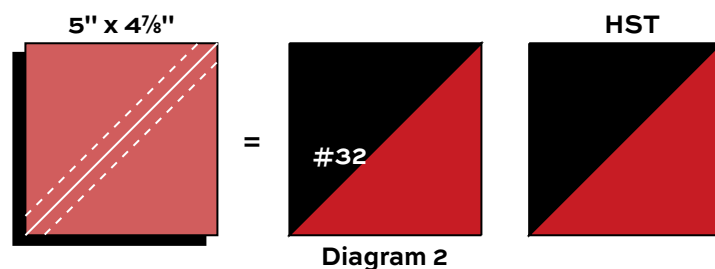
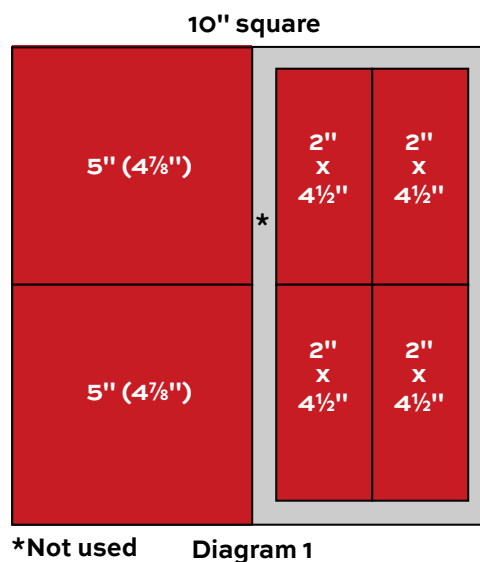
***Fabrics 31 and 32 squares are not needed. They both require more yardage.

Fabric Requirements	Yardage	Fabric
White blocks	2½ yards	31
Black blocks	2 yards	32
29 Jewels blocks	10" square pack	
Binding	⅝ yard	32
Backing	4¾ yards	31

Bejeweled Quilt

Making the Quilt

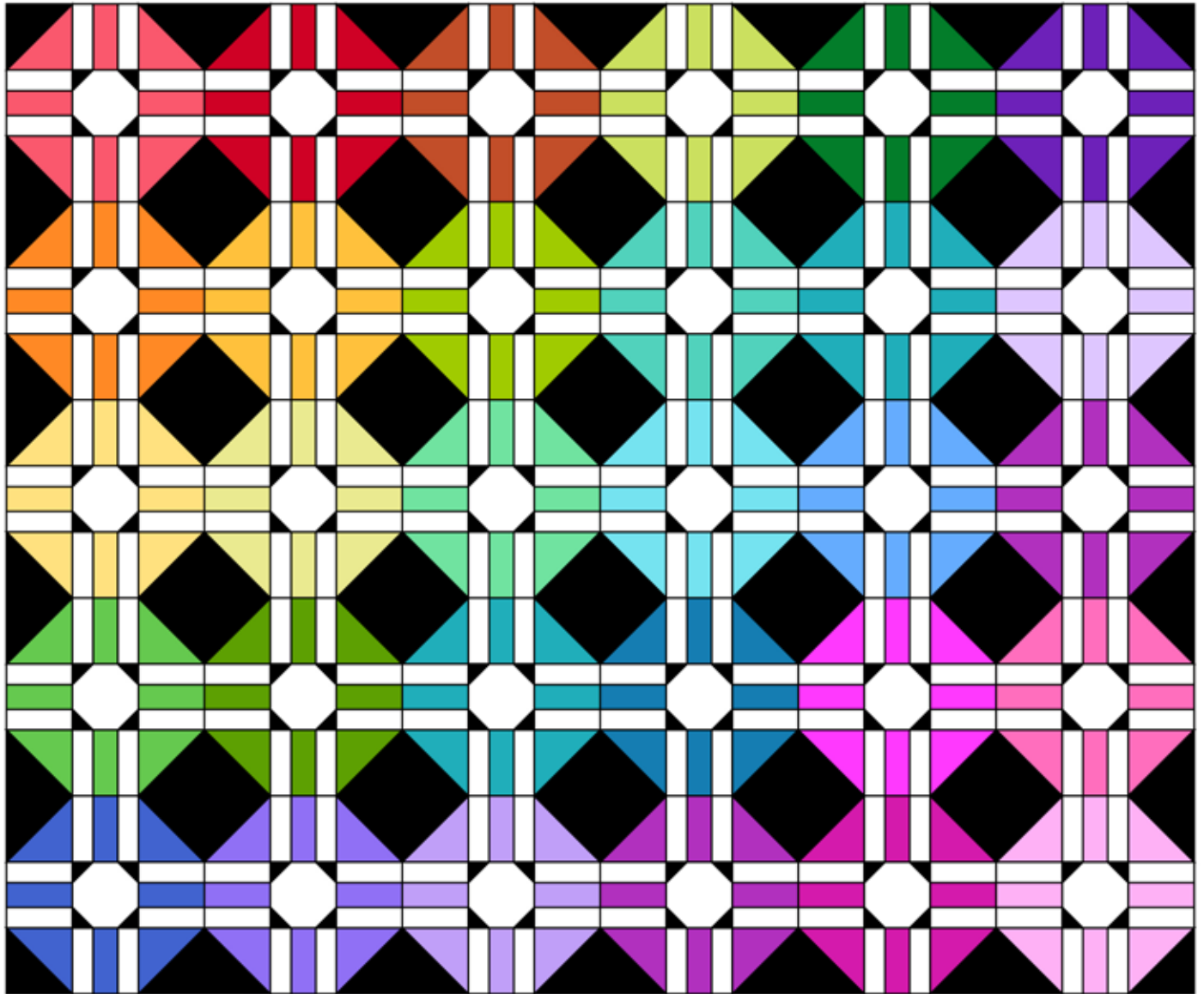
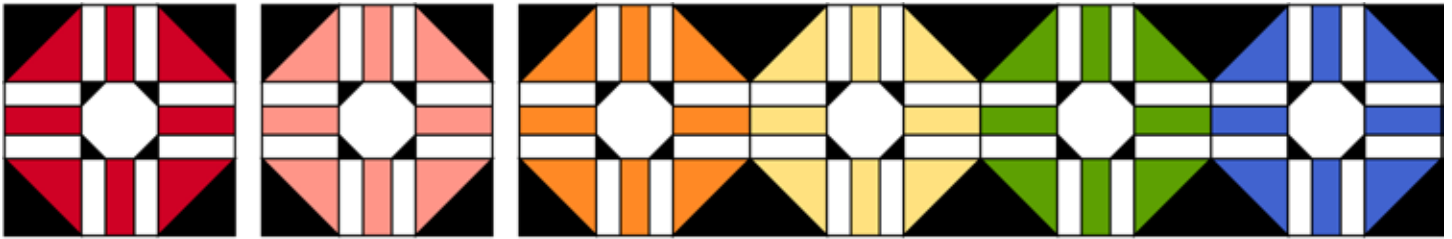
1. Refer to Diagram 1 for cutting each 10" square. Cut 2 squares 5" or 4⁷/₈". (Read Step 2 before cutting.) Also cut 4 rectangles 2" x 4¹/₂" as shown. Note: Some fabrics have 2 squares that are 10" in the pack while some have only one square. You will use all the squares except Fabrics 19, 31, and 32. You need only one square of Fabric 29.
2. The blocks are made with half-square triangles (HST). Use your favorite method to make HST that finish 4", or follow these directions. Fabric squares cut 5" will be trimmed after stitching. Cut the squares 4⁷/₈" if you do not wish to trim later. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a Jewel 5" square. With right sides together, position the marked square on top of a Fabric 32 square. Stitch ¹/₄" on each side of the diagonal line (Diagram 2). Cut apart on the drawn line. Trim the square to 4¹/₂" if needed. Press the seam allowance toward the darker fabric. Make 4 HST alike for each block.
3. The Center Units are made with a quick stitch-and-flip method. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the small Fabric 32 squares. Position a marked square as shown on each corner of a 4¹/₂" Fabric 31 square (Diagram 3). Stitch on the marked diagonal lines. Cut away the excess fabric. Press the corner up. Make a Center Unit for each block.
4. Refer to the Block diagram. Sew a Jewel fabric rectangle between 2 Fabric 31 rectangles to make a Side Unit. Press the seam allowance toward the Jewel strip. Make 4 alike for each block.
5. Arrange 4 HST, the Center Unit, and 4 Side Units in 3 rows as shown. Be careful to orient the HST so the black triangles are in the corners. Join the units in each row. Press seam allowances in opposite directions between the rows. Finally, join the rows. Make 36 Blocks.
6. Referring to the Quilt Assembly, arrange the blocks in 6 rows of 6 blocks each, orienting the colors as shown or as you wish. Once you are satisfied with the arrangement, join the blocks into rows, and then join the rows.



Finishing the Quilt

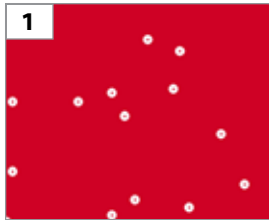
7. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around patches. Quilt a motif inside the black triangles where they meet. Or, quilt an overall design. Bind to finish the quilt.

Quilt Assembly

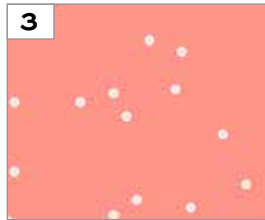
