

# **Continuum Quilt**

What a fun opportunity to play with color! Follow the quilt diagram and photograph or rearrange the colored strips to echo your own design sensibilities. This is a perfect throw-size quilt for someone with little or no quiltmaking experience, or for anyone in need of a quick project.

# **Cutting Directions**

**Note:** Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. A fat  $\frac{1}{8}$  is a 9" x 20"-22" cut. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately  $\frac{43}{9}$ " wide).

#### Fabric A

Cut (2) borders 9½" x 60½", cut lengthwise

Cut (3) sashes  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $60\frac{1}{2}$ "

Cut (4) rectangles 6½" x 12½"

Cut (4) rectangles 4½" x 12½"

#### **47 Fabrics**

From 42: Cut (1) rectangle  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " From 5: Cut (2) rectangles  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ "

#### **Binding**

Cut (7) strips 2½" x WOF for binding

#### **Backing**

Cut (2) lengths 41" x 70", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides



### **Making the Quilt**

- 1. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange the 52 colored strips in 4 horizontal rows, placing a Fabric A strip between each. On rows 1 and 3, position a Fabric A 4½" x 12½" patch on the left end and a 6½" x 12½" patch on the right end. On rows 2 and 4, reverse the placement of the end patches.
- **2.** Once you are satisfied with the color placement, join the patches to make 4 rows. Press seam allowances toward the colored strips.
- 3. Sew the Fabric A 2½" sashes between the rows.
- **4.** Finally, sew the borders to the top and bottom.


# **Finishing the Quilt**

**5.** Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and patches, or quilt an overall pattern. Bind to finish the quilt.
