

# **Faithful Flag**





Quilt finishes 54" x 72" Block size: 9" x 9" Your love of country will be on display with this patriotic quilt, just the right size to snuggle on or under while watching fireworks. Star and Log Cabin blocks combine to make this original setting. The detailed diagrams for fast piecing methods make this easy enough for anyone with a little sewing experience. Choose from two layouts to make either a vertical or horizontal flag.

### **Cutting Directions**

**Note:** Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include 1/4" seam allowances. A fat 1/4 is an 18" x 20"-22" cut. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 43" wide).

#### Fabric A

Cut (15) squares  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " for star blocks Cut (5) squares 4" (or  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " for HST) Read Step 1 before cutting.

#### Fabric B

Cut (15) squares 3½" for log cabin block centers

#### Fabric C

Cut (12) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks Cut (12) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks

#### Fabric D

Cut (21) squares  $3\frac{1}{2}$  for star blocks Cut (7) squares 4" (or  $3\frac{1}{8}$  for HST) Read Step 1 before cutting.

#### Fabric E

Cut (12) squares 3½" for log cabin block centers

#### Fabric F

Cut (15) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks Cut (15) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks

#### Fabric G

Cut (9) squares 3½" for star blocks Cut (3) squares 4" (or 3½" for HST) Read Step 1 before cutting

#### Fabric H

Cut (18) squares 3½" for star blocks
Cut (6) squares 4" (or 3½" for HST)
Read Step 1 before cutting
Cut (12) strips 1½" x 7½" for log cabin blocks
Cut (12) strips 1½" x 6½" for log cabin blocks

#### Fabric I

Cut (15) squares 3½" for star blocks Cut (5) squares 4" (or 3¾" for HST) Read Step 1 before cutting

#### Fabric J

Cut (12) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks Cut (12) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks Cut (15) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks Cut (15) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks

#### Fabric K

Cut (15) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks Cut (15) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks

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#### **Cutting Directions continued**

#### Fabric L

Cut (27) squares 3½" for star blocks Cut (9) squares 4" (or 3¾" for HST) Read Step 1 before cutting

#### Fabric M

Cut (12) strips 1½" x 6½" for log cabin blocks Cut (12) strips 1½" x 5½" for log cabin blocks Cut (15) strips 1½" x 4½" for log cabin blocks Cut (15) strips 1½" x 3½" for log cabin blocks

#### Fabric N

Cut (12) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks Cut (12) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks

#### Fabric O

Cut (21) squares 3½" for star blocks Cut (7) squares 4" (or 3¾" for HST) Read Step 1 before cutting

#### Fabric P

Cut (15) strips 1½" x 8½" for log cabin blocks Cut (15) strips 1½" x 7½" for log cabin blocks Cut (12) strips 1½" x 4½" for log cabin blocks Cut (12) strips 1½" x 3½" for log cabin blocks

#### Fabric Q

Cut (15) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks Cut (15) strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabin blocks

#### Fabric R

Cut (63) squares 2" for star points Cut (32) squares 2½" (or 2¾" for HST) Read Step 2 before cutting

#### Fabric S

Cut (63) squares 2" for star points Cut (32) squares 2½" (or 2¾" for HST) Read Step 2 before cutting

#### Fabric T

Cut (42) squares 2" for star points Cut (21) squares 2½" (or 2¾" for HST) Read Step 2 before cutting

#### **Binding**

Cut (7) strips  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for binding

#### **Backing**

Cut (2) lengths 40" x 62", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

# **Making the Quilt**

- 1. The star blocks use half-square triangles (HST). Use your favorite method to make HST that finish 3", or follow these directions. Squares that are cut 4" will be trimmed after stitching. Cut the squares 3 %" if you do not wish to trim later. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the lighter 4" squares. With right sides together, position the marked square on top of a second square. Stitch ¼" on each side of the diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut apart on the drawn line. Press the seam allowance toward the darker fabric. Trim the HST to 3½" if needed. Make 2 HST this size for each star block, referring to Diagram 1 for the number needed of each fabric combination.
- 2. The center of each star block is made with 4 HST that finish 1½" square. Refer to Step 1. Cut 2½" (2¾") squares to make the number of small HST in the fabrics shown in Diagram 2. Trim the HST to 2" if needed.





Diagram 1 - Make 10 HST







# Faithful Flag Quilt

- **3.** The star blocks use pieced units made with a stitch-and-flip method for the star points. Draw a diagonal line on Fabrics R, S, and T 2" squares. Stitch on the marked diagonal line. Cut away the excess fabric. Press the corner up. Repeat this step on the adjacent corner (Diagram 3). The star point unit should measure 3½" square. Make the number of units in the fabric combinations as shown for each star block.
- 4. Referring to star block 1 diagram, arrange 2 large HST, 4 star point units, 2 squares 3½", and 4 small HST for the block centers. Rotate the fabrics as shown to duplicate the design. Stand back to be sure that all the parts are correct, noting that each Fabric R patch in the center HST touches a Fabric R star point. Likewise, Fabric S patches touch, as well as Fabric T patches. Once you are satisfied that the design is correct, join the patches and units in 3 rows. Finally, join the rows. Make the number of star blocks in the combinations as shown.








**Star Point Unit**




## Faithful Flag Quilt


- **5.** Arrange the appropriate log cabin strips around a center Fabric B or E 3½" square. Join the strips to the center square in a clockwise direction. Make 15 Log Cabin 1 and 12 Log Cabin 2.
- **6.** Choose either the vertical or horizontal layout. On a design wall or flat surface, refer to the chosen Quilt Diagram and position the blocks in rows. Note the rotation of all blocks. Looking through the wrong end of binoculars or through a camera will help you identify any out-of-place block. Once you are sure of the design, join the blocks into rows, and then join the rows.

## **Finishing the Quilt**


7. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around patches. Or, quilt an overall design. Bind to finish the quilt.




**Quilt Diagram - Vertical**
