## Quilt Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.** Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

- Fabric A** Cut (1) 10" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 10" squares.
- Fabric B** Cut (1) 10" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 10" squares.
- Fabric C** Cut (1) 10" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 10" squares.
- Fabric D** Cut (1) 10" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 10" squares.
- Fabric E** Cut (1) 10" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 10" squares.
- Fabric F** Cut (3) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 5 1/4" squares.
- Fabric G** Cut (4) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 5 1/4" squares.
- Fabric H** Cut (3) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 5 1/4" squares.
- Fabric I** Cut (4) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 5 1/4" squares.  
Cut (11) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.
- Fabric J** Cut (4) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (23) 5 1/4" squares.
- Fabric K** Cut (6) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 5 1/4" x 10" strips.

- Fabric L** Cut (6) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 5 1/4" x 10" strips.
- Fabric M** Cut (4) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 5 1/4" squares.
- Fabric N** Cut (4) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 5 1/4" x 10" strips.
- Fabric O** Cut (4) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (15) 5 1/4" x 10" strips.
- Fabric P** Cut (2) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 5 1/4" squares.
- Fabric Q** Cut (9) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (62) 5 1/4" squares.
- Fabric R** Cut (6) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/4" x 100 1/4" strips.  
Cut (5) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips

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## Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued

together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/4" x 86" strips.

**Fabric S** Cut (1) 10" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 10" squares.

**Backing** Cut (3) 94" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 94" x 118" backing.

## Making the Quilt

**Note: The arrows in the figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.**

### 1. Block Assembly

Place (1) 5 1/4" Fabric F square on the left side of (1) 5 1/4" x 10" Fabric K strip, right sides together (Diagram 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Diagram 2).

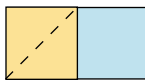

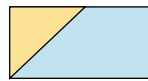

2. Place another 5 1/4" Fabric F square on the right side of the 5 1/4" x 10" Fabric K strip, right sides together (Diagram 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Diagram 4).

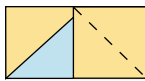

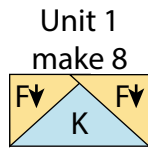

4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Diagrams 5-11 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make the indicated number of unit strips for Unit 2 through Unit 8.

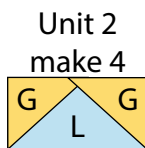

5. Sew (1) 5 1/4" Fabric M square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 10" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 19 1/2" Block One square (Diagram 12).

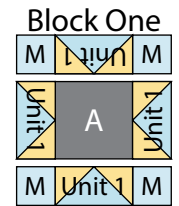

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Diagrams 13-23 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) of each block square for Block Two through Block Twelve.

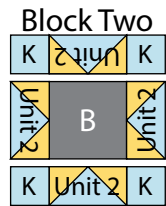

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**16.** Sew (1) 5 1/2" Fabric J square, (1) Block Fourteen rectangle, (1) 5 1/4" Fabric P square, (1) Block Fourteen rectangle, (1) 5 1/4" Fabric J square, (1) Block Fourteen rectangle and (1) 5 1/4" Fabric P square together in that order from left to right to make the Top Border (Diagram 29). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.



## Quilt Top Assembly

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)*

**17.** Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.

**18.** Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

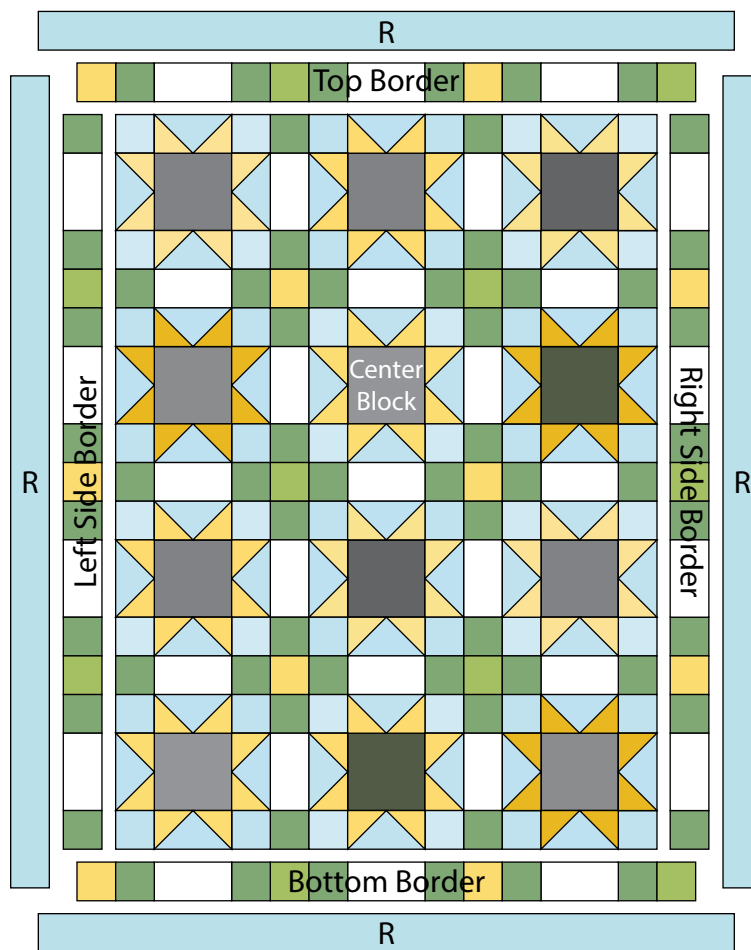
**19.** Sew (1) 5 1/4" x 100 1/4" Fabric R strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/4" x 86" Fabric R strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

**20.** Layer and quilt as desired.

**21.** Sew the (11) Fabric I binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

**22.** Bind as desired.

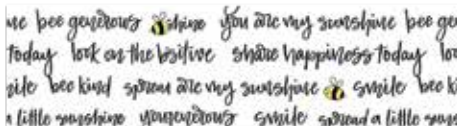

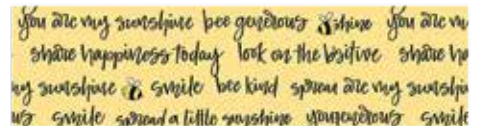
