May the luck o' the Irish be with you as you make one or all of these projects. Not just for St. Paddy's day, the easy-to-piece runner and placemats can brighten your dining any time of the year. Fast-to-fuse shamrocks add a touch of the blarney as well.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include 1/4" seam allowances. A fat 1/8 is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvage to selvage (approximately 43" wide).

Binding	3/8 yard	CS-10-Black
Backing	1 1/4 yards	475-K

Fabric A

Cut (14) squares 3 1/2" for pieced border (read Step 2 before cutting)

14 Prints

From each:
Cut (7) squares 3 1/2" (some fabrics should be fussy-cut to center the motif)

4 Greens

From each:
Cut (3 or 4) shamrocks, 14 total (read Step 2 before cutting)

Binding

Cut (4) strips 2 1/2" x WOF for binding

Backing

Cut (2) lengths 28" x 28", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Making the Table Runner

1. Refer to the diagram and photograph to position the 3 1/2" squares in 14 rows of 7 squares each, being sure that no fabric touches itself. Once you are satisfied with the arrangement, join the squares into rows. Press seam allowances in opposite directions in alternating rows. Finally, join the rows.
2. You may wish to cut the Fabric A background squares slightly larger, and trim after appliqué. Prepare the 14 shamrocks for fusible appliqué. Center each shamrock on a black 3 1/2" (or larger) square. Fuse in place. Finish the edges with a contrasting or matching thread using a narrow zigzag or straight stitch. Trim each square to 3 1/2" if needed.
3. Join 7 shamrock squares to make a border. Sew to the top of the runner. Repeat for the bottom.

Finishing the Runner

4. Layer the runner with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around patches. Quilt around the shamrocks and printed motifs. Bind to finish the runner.

4 Greens shamrocks	fat 1/8 each	
CS-10-Emerald	CS-10-Guacamole

Binding	1/2 yard	CS-10-Black
Backing	1 1/2 yards	475-K

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include 1/4" seam allowances. A fat 1/8 is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 43" wide).

Fabric A

Cut (16) squares 3 1/2" for pieced border
(read Step 2 before cutting)
[Cut 4 squares for 1 placemat.]

14 Prints

From each:
Cut (5 or 6) squares 3 1/2", 80 total
(some fabrics should be fussy-cut to center the motif)
[Cut 20 squares for 1 placemat.]

4 Greens

From each:
Cut (4) shamrocks (16 total)
[Cut 4 shamrocks for 1 placemat.]

Binding

Cut (7) strips 2 1/2" x WOF for binding
all 4 placemats
[Piece a strip 2 1/2" x 70" for 1 placemat.]

Backing

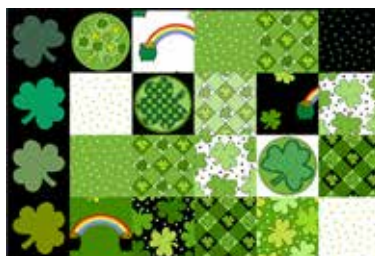
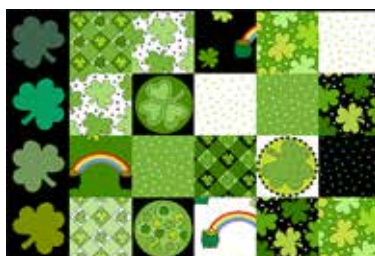
Cut (4) lengths 18" x 24", pieced to fit quilt
[Cut 1 length for 1 placemat.]

Making 1 Placemat

1. Refer to the diagram and photograph to position the 3 1/2" squares in 4 rows of 5 squares each, being sure that no fabric touches itself. Once you are satisfied with the arrangement, join the squares into rows. Press seam allowances in opposite directions in alternating rows. Finally, join the rows.
2. Follow Step 2 for the table runner to appliqué the shamrocks to 4 black squares.
3. Join 4 shamrock squares to make a border. Sew to the side of the placemat.

Finishing the Placemat

4. Refer to Step 4 for the table runner.

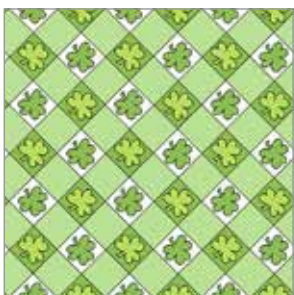

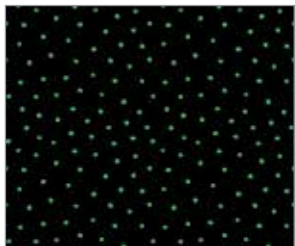

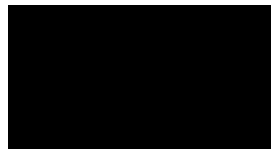
