Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Jelly Bean

Fabric A1 Cut (1) 4 ½" x 12 ½" strip.

Fabric B1 Cut (2) 2 ½" x 16 ½" strips
Cut (2) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips
Cut (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding

Fabric C1 See instructions to trace and cut applique shapes.

Backing Cut (1) 12" x 20" piece for the backing.

Basic Hand Embroidery supplies
Matching Embroidery Floss

Fabric A2 Cut (1) 4 ½" x 12 ½" strip.

Fabric B2 Cut (2) 2 ½" x 16 ½" strips
Cut (2) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips
Cut (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding

Fabric C2 See instructions to trace and cut applique shapes.

Backing Cut (1) 12" x 20" piece for the backing.

Neutral

Fabric A3 Cut (1) 4 ½" x 12 ½" strip.

Fabric B3 Cut (2) 2 ½" x 16 ½" strips
Cut (2) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips
Cut (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding

Fabric C3 See instructions to trace and cut applique shapes.

Backing Cut (1) 12" x 20" piece for the backing.

Stars and Stripes

- Fabric A4** Cut (1) 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" strip.
- Fabric B4** Cut (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 1/2" squares.
Cut (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for binding
- Fabric C4** See instructions to trace and cut applique shapes.
- Backing** Cut (1) 12" x 20" piece for the backing.

You will also need:

- Basic Hand Embroidery supplies
- Matching Embroidery Floss

Jelly Bean - Making the Quilt

- Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric B1 strip to each end of the 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric A1 strip. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B1 strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A strip to make Unit 1 (Diagram 1).



- Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- Press each template onto the wrong side of the wool fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- Refer to the Jelly Bean Quilt Layout to arrange and press the assorted components onto the quilt top (Diagram 2).

Jelly Bean Layout



Jelly Bean - Finishing the Quilt

- Layer and quilt as desired.
- Sew the (2) Fabric B1 binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- Bind as desired.

Jewels - Making the Quilt

- Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric B2 strip to each end of the 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric A2 strip. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B2 strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A2 strip to make Unit 2 (Diagram 3).



Mini Quilts



Jewel - Finishing the Quilt

- Layer and quilt as desired.
- Sew the (2) Fabric B2 binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- Bind as desired.

Neutral - Making the Quilt

- Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric B3 strip to each end of the 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric A3 strip. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric B3 strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A3 strip to make Unit 3 (Diagram 5).



- Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- Refer to the Neutral Quilt Layout to arrange and press the assorted components onto the quilt top (Diagram 6).



Mini Quilts

Neutral - Finishing the Quilt

- 22. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 23. Sew the (2) Fabric B3 binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 24. Bind as desired.

Stars and Stripes - Making the Quilt

- 25. Sew together (2) 2 1/2" Fabric A4 squares to make one side border. Repeat to make a second side border. Sew together (8) 2 1/2" Fabric A4 squares to make the top border. Repeat to make the bottom border.
- 26. Sew the sewn side borders to each side of the 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric A4 strip. Sew the sewn top and bottom borders to the top and bottom of the Fabric A4 strip (Diagram 7).



- 27. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 28. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

- 29. Refer to the Stars and Stripes Quilt Layout to arrange and press the assorted components onto the quilt top (Diagram 8).












Stars and Stripes - Finishing the Quilt

- 31. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 32. Sew the (2) Fabric B4 binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 33. Bind as desired.


