

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A Cut (2) 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (3) 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut each 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ " square across both diagonals to make (12) Side Triangles.

Cut (1) 9 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 9 $\frac{3}{8}$ " squares. Cut (1) 9 $\frac{3}{8}$ " square across the diagonal from the upper right corner to the lower left corner to make (2) Corner Triangles. Cut the remaining 9 $\frac{3}{8}$ " square across the diagonal from the upper left corner to the lower right corner to make (2) Corner Triangles.

Cut (1) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric B Cut (2) 18" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (4) 18" squares. Cut (1) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square on point from each 18" square (Diagram 1).



Fabric C Cut (2) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (5) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric D Cut (2) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (4) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric E Cut (2) 18" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (3) 18" squares. Cut (1) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square on point from each 18" square (Diagram 1).

Fabric F	Cut (2) 18" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (4) 18" squares. Cut (1) 12 1/2" square on point from each 18" square (Diagram 1).
Fabric G	Cut (1) 12 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) 12 1/2" squares.

Making the Quilt

1. Block Assembly

Following the manufacturer's instructions to trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

- Refer to the Diagram 2 to arrange and press the (4) Fabric H Petals onto the 12 1/2" Fabric B square. Arrange and press (1) Fabric O Center Square onto the Fabric B square to make (1) Block One square.



- Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.

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4. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Diagrams 3-26 for fabric identification and placement to make (1) of each block for Block Two through Block Twenty-Five.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to Diagram 27 and the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- Sew (1) Fabric A Corner Triangle to the top of the Block One square. Sew (1) Fabric A Side Triangle to each side of the Block One square to make Row 1.
- Sew together (1) Fabric A Side Triangle, Block Two, Block Three, Block Four and (1) Fabric A Side Triangle, in that order, to make Row 2.
- Sew together (1) Fabric A Side Triangle, Block Five, Block Six, Block Seven, Block Eight, Block Nine and (1) Fabric A Side Triangle, in that order, to make Row 3.
- Sew together (1) Fabric A Corner Triangle, Block Ten, Block Eleven, Block Twelve, Block Thirteen, Block Fourteen, Block Fifteen, Block Sixteen and (1) Fabric A Corner Triangle, in that order, to make Row 4.

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9. Sew together (1) Fabric A Side Triangle, Block Seventeen, Block Eighteen, Block Nineteen, Block Twenty, Block Twenty-One and (1) Fabric A Side Triangle, in that order, to make Row 5.

10. Sew together (1) Fabric A Side Triangle, Block Twenty-Two, Block Twenty-Three, Block Twenty-Four and (1) Fabric A Side Triangle, in that order, to make Row 6.

11. Sew (1) Fabric A Corner Triangle to the bottom of the Block Twenty-Five square. Sew (1) Fabric A Side Triangle to each side of the Block Twenty-Five square to make Row 7.

12. Sew together the (7) Rows, in numerical order, to make the Center Block (Diagram 27).




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


Finishing the Quilt

13. Layer and quilt as desired.
14. Sew the (7) Fabric Z binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
15. Bind as desired.
